

LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES 2024



Alcohol Service

- Extend provisions allowed for by Act 81 of 2021 as it relates to outdoor extension of premises.
- Advocate for wholesale purchase relief:
 - » Advance licensee discount legislation
 - » Explore other forms of relief



Government Affairs

 Preserve the tipped wage as this system guarantees at least minimum wage with a much higher upside for tipped employees and allows restaurant owners the capability to reinvest in their non-tipped employees and business.



Lodging & Tourism

- Advance legislation enabling the establishment of Tourism Improvement Districts (TIDs), protect hotel tax for tourism purposes, and preserve recent increases in tourism funding.
- Combat human trafficking.
- Explore and assess the growing short-term rental economy.
